



## **Disciplinary procedure Cont.**

If the offense occurs in the last game of the season, the proscribed suspension will be effective for the following season or the next season that the violator participates in. These penalties are automatic and do not require a ruling by a league official or a vote by the board. The coach, parent, or player may appeal to the league President. After investigating the facts and circumstances surrounding the misconduct, the league President may overrule the proscribed suspension or continue with the necessary penalty.

The President's decision can then be appealed to the board where a majority vote must be obtained in order to alter the ruling.

The PYBSA board as a whole can skip the levels above if it is determined that an offense requires skipping levels of the actions written above with a majority vote from the executive officers.

Anytime a coach, player, and or parent or spectator is at Pitsenberger complex, team practice or any other location during a PYBSA team practice, game or event the above guidelines and rules are in effect.
